Touki-Bouki

Djibril Diop Mambety Senegal, 1973, 95 min.

Touki-Bouki (The Hyena's Journey) is a stylistically sophisticated African "Bonnie and Clyde" story about a young couple who yearn to live the glamorous life in France, but must first pull off a couple of heists to buy their tickets out of Dakar.

Hyenas

Djibril Diop Mambety Senegal, 1992, 113 min.

Linguere Ramatou, a woman as "rich as the World Bank" returns to the decaying backwater of Colobane where she bribes the villagers with the glitter of consumer culture to kill her former lover, Dramaan Drameh. Dramaan had betrayed Ramatou for a wealthier wife and then cast her out of the village when she became pregnant with his child.

La petite vendeuse de Soleil /
The Little Girl Who Sold The Sun
Djibril Diop Mambety
Senegal/Switzerland, 1999, 45 min.

In this last film before his untimely death, Mambety moves beyond documenting Africa's victimization towards envisioning the continent's recovery. He finds hope in this tale of a handicapped girl's determination to sell Le Soleil, the national newspaper of Senegal. Despite harrassment and greedy police, her indomitable spirit enables her to overcome her disabilities.

Le Franc

Djibril Diop Mambety Senegal, 1994, 45 min.

The hero of this slapstick tribute to Africa's poor is Marigo, a down-on-his-luck musician, whose landlady has confiscated his beloved *congoma* (an African instrument) for back rent. In a desperate attempt to reclaim his *comgoma*, he buys a lottery ticket. When he wins, he finds that redeeming his ticket is no easy feat.

South Africa, 1998, 11 min.

An unemployed man accepts a day job from a mysterious farmer. What might have been a regular day of manual labor however turns into a harrowing psychological experience.

Junaid Ahmed South Africa, 1998, 11 min.

A father hopes that his vow during the Hindu ceremony, Kavady, will cure his mute son. Although unsuccessful in keeping the vow, he and his son are drawn closer together through near disaster.

Watercolors

Nantie Steyn South Africa, 1998, 11 min.

The mayor of a South African town buys the public swimming pool so his girlfriend won't have to share it with blacks. But she refuses his "gift."

Portrait of A Young Man Drowning

Teboho Mahlatsi South Africa, 1998, 11 min.

In a tough urban township, a killer seeks redemption and finds that his community is not willing to accept his desire to change. with


